## BALLOT MEASURES

### PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENTS

*These questions will be on ALL ballots*

Question 1: **Use of private funds in election administration.** Shall section 7 (1) of article III of the constitution be created to provide that private donations and grants may not be applied for, accepted, expended, or used in connection with the conduct of any primary, election, or referendum?

**VOTE NO**

Question 2: **Election officials.** Shall section 7 (2) of article III of the constitution be created to provide that only election officials designated by law may perform tasks in the conduct of primaries, elections, and referendums?

**VOTE NO**

**Elections need to be fully funded. These proposed constitutional amendments put our elections at risk.**

**The lack of reform to the state funding formula model and revenue caps are putting school districts statewide at risk. Should the operational referendums fail, it will inevitably lead to reductions in staff and program offerings.**

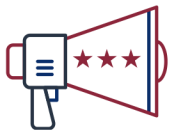
